

ORDINANCE #: 2005-01

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Gosport, Indiana, believes that it is in the public interest and welfare to ban by ordinance skateboarding and other skating activities within certain portions of the downtown business district.

IT IS NOW THEREFORE ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOSPORT, OWEN COUNTY, INDIANA:


1. That no person shall roller skate, in-line skate or otherwise engage in skateboarding activities of any nature whatsoever in the area:

- a. Bounded on the east by Third Street and bounded on the west by Fifth Street and
- b. Running from Main Street north and including the alleyway parallel with North Street between Third Street and Fifth Street and
- c. Running from Main Street south and including the alleyway parallel with Main Street between Third Street and Fifth Street.

2. That any person who shall violate this ordinance (or the parent or guardian of any minor child who shall violate said ordinance) shall pay a fine to the Gosport Town Clerk/Treasurer in the sum of Twenty Five Dollars (\$25.00). If suit is brought to collect said amount through legal process, the Defendant shall pay the reasonable costs of the Town of Gosport in pursuing payment, including, but not limited to, court costs and reasonable attorney fees.

3. That the provisions of Ordinance 09-2002 to the extent that they apply to the banned activities of roller skating, in-line skating, and skateboarding in restricted areas of the Town of Gosport are incorporated by reference into this ordinance and are made a part hereof.


This ORDINANCE was passed and adopted by the Town Council of the Town of Gosport, Indiana, on the 19 day of January, 2005.
